Subject Choices Information

In addition to a full year programme of Social Studies, Science, Physical Education, Health, Mathematics and English, all Year 9 students will study nine other subjects which they will select. These nine choice subjects will each run for 11 weeks.

The New Zealand Curriculum Framework states that students should undertake a balanced programme. Students will be guided in their choices so that they select at least one subject from within The Arts, Languages and Technology.
