

Ashburton College Course Selection Form for Year 12 Students in 2019

Read the Course Descriptions Booklet for information about the courses being offered and talk to the Careers Co-Ordinator for advice.

Discuss your proposed courses with parents, deans or family form teachers.

We are anticipating that a parent portal for our course selection will be available for parents to enter information.

General Information

- Unless otherwise stated the general standard for entry to Year 12 courses is 60 Level 1 NCEA credits. If you do not achieve the general entry standard you may be required to repeat Year 11, or do a mix of Year 11 and 12 subjects.
- You may study courses at NCEA Level 1 and Level 2 (Level 3 by discussion with Dean/Head of School).
- You must select **six** courses (you must also indicate a seventh option in case any of your first choices are unavailable).
- You must take a course in English. This can be met by a course in NCEA Level 1 or NCEA Level 2 English.
- You must check the Course Descriptions Booklet to see if there are any Entry Requirements for your course choices.
- In a limited number of cases, entry may be granted to a course where the Entry Requirement has not been met. Only a Head of School or Dean can make this decision and only after consultation with the teacher in charge of the course.
- If you intend to take *NCEA Level 3 or 4* courses in 2019 you should check the Entry Requirements for these courses.
- If you intend to go to University or Polytech, you should check their Entry Requirements (prerequisites) also.
- University Entrance requires you to achieve 14 credits in each of the three approved subjects at Level 3, to have literacy at Level 2 (5 reading and 5 writing) and numeracy at Level 1. Many courses now require achievements at Merit or Excellence level. Check your choices are UE approved in the course booklet.
- To receive NCEA Level 2 students must achieve 60 credits from Level 2 or higher and another 20 from any other level.
- All Year 12 students take part in a year-long programme, called Transition, designed to give them information and skills to assist them in their life beyond school.
- Make sure you are aware of the Voluntary Course Contributions involved with some courses.
 These are found in the Course Descriptions Booklet.
- Courses will only run if staff and resources are available.
- If numbers are too low for a particular course (class), that course (class) may be cancelled or combined with the same course at another level.
- Your course selection is used to prepare next year's timetable and to appoint staff.
- You are not expected to change your selection unless:
 - o Your examination results are very different from what you expected.
 - Class numbers allow a change.
 - o There is a change in staff.
- While we will endeavour to meet all course choices, there may be combinations of courses that simply cannot be timetabled and these students may be asked to choose an alternative course or to look at enrolling in an on-line course through Video Conferencing or with the Correspondence School
