Course Selection Form for Year 13 Students in 2019

Read the Course Descriptions Booklet for information about the courses being offered and talk to the Careers Co-Ordinator for advice.

Discuss your proposed courses with parents, deans or family form teachers.

We are anticipating that a parent portal for our course selection will be available for parents to enter information.

General Information

- Unless otherwise stated, the general standard for entry to Year 13 courses is 60 *Level 2* NCEA credits. If you do not achieve the general entry standard you may be required to repeat Year 12, or do a mix of Year 12 and 13 subjects.
- You may study courses at *NCEA Level 1, Level 2* and *Level 3*.
- You must select **five** courses. See the Head of School/Deputy Principal if you want to enter six *Level 3* courses. You must also indicate another potential course if your first options are not available.
- English is not compulsory for Year 13 students.
- You must check the Course Descriptions Booklet to see if there are any Entry Requirements for your course choices.
- *In a limited number of cases*, entry may be granted to a course where the Entry Requirement has not been met. Only a Head of School or Dean can make this decision and only after consultation with the teacher in charge of the course.
- If you intend to go to University or Polytech, you should also check their Entry Requirements (pre-requisites).
- To receive *NCEA Level 3* students must achieve 60 credits from *Level 3* or higher and another 20 from *Level 2*.
- University Entrance requires you to achieve 14 credits in each of the three approved subjects at *Level 3*, to have literacy at *Level 2* (5 reading and 5 writing) and numeracy at *Level 1*. Many courses now require achievements at Merit or Excellence level. Check your choices are UE approved in the course booklet.
- Make sure you are aware of the Course Contributions involved with some courses. These are found in the Course Descriptions Booklet.
- Courses will only run if staff and resources are available.
- If numbers are too low for a particular course (class), that course (class) may be cancelled or combined with the same course at another level.
- Your course selection is used to prepare next year's timetable and to appoint staff.
- You are not expected to change your selection unless:
 - Your examination results are very different from what you expected.
 - Class numbers allow a change.
 - There is a change in staff.
- ***While we will endeavour to meet all course choices, there may be combinations of courses that simply cannot be timetabled and these students may be asked to choose an alternative course or to look at enrolling in a Video Conference programme or at the Correspondence School.***
